Wisconsin River Pro Rodeo Queen & Princess <u>Titleholder Expectations</u>

IF you are selected as the new Wisconsin River Pro Rodeo Queen or Princess, you will be expected to abide by the following during your reign:

- 1. Appearances (required)
 - a. Four (4) PRCA sanctioned rodeos
 - b. Tomahawk 4th of July Parade (horseback)
 - c. Merrill Labor Day Parade (horseback)
 - d. Merrill Christmas Day Parade (on WRPR float or truck)
 - e. WRPR Queen Banquet
 - f. Radio interviews the week of the WRPR, as set forth by the WRPR committee
 - g. Reading at the TB Scott Library (Friday morning of the rodeo)
 - h. Other miscellaneous promotional events as determined by the WRPR committee
- 2. Suggested Appearances (not required)
 - a. Horse fairs/expos (i.e. Midwest Horse Fair, Minnesota Horse Expo, etc)
 - b. Schools
 - c. Nursing homes/senior centers
 - d. Local open house or fundraiser type events (i.e. Stable Hands fundraiser)
- 3. Be responsible for your own transportation to and from all events and appearances.
- 4. Dress in appropriate attire
 - a. Crown, sash, buckle, boots, hat, etc
 - b. Jeans should not be faded, wrinkled, or have holes
 - c. Attire must be appropriate; no cleavage, short sleeves, or tank tops
 - d. Hair should be neatly styled
 - e. No visible tattoos or facial piercings
- 5. Queen & Princess are expected to be honest and display good sportsmanship, behavior, and etiquette at all times when representing the WRPR, including no drinking, smoking, drugs, or cellphones during appearances.
- 6. Assume full financial responsibility for any appearances made as WRPR Queen or Princess.

Failure to carry out these expectations as listed can and will result in dismissal of the title, which will then be passed on to the next runner-up.
